Maple Lake Recovery Centers started in 1997 as a Minnesota non-profit treatment program to provide a welcoming environment where adolescents and their families struggling with addiction and associated behaviors could live, grow, and learn the essential principles, values, life skills, and techniques for long term, successful recovery.

Through the dedication of our staff and support of our many community partners, Maple Lake Recovery Centers now includes adolescent female and male residential chemical dependency programs.

Our goal remains simple: We are here to help as many adolescents as possible recover from addiction and realize their dreams through developing the skills needed to contribute to family, community, and the world by living a meaningful and effective life without drugs or alcohol. We continue to be recognized by many of our partners as a "provider of choice" of unique, effective adolescent substance abuse recovery services.

A PLACE WHERE BOYS CAN RECLAIM THEIR YOUTH ON THE WAY TO BECOMING RESPONSIBLE MEN...

Adolescent males can get lost in addiction; robbed of their formative years in life, become filled with anger, rage, worry, and fear; the emotional byproducts of drug and alcohol use and their associated behaviors. These are typically young men at a crossroads, both heartbreaking and worrisome. "How do we stop this? what can we do?" There is a solution.

Maple Lake Recovery Center (MLRC) is a 16-bed residential addiction treatment program for males offering boys between age 13-18 and their families a structured, safe, yet challenging recovery environment where they can grow in emotional and mental maturity and self-esteem. It's a program where teens can reclaim their youth while becoming responsible young men. Our programs are designed to reintegrate adolescent males back into their homes and communities chemically free and with effective sober support systems, 12 step meeting experience, improved coping, planning, problem solving, and decision making skills, and a history of success upon which to build a useful and meaningful life.

OUR CORE TREATMENT SERVICES

Licensed addiction counseling and educational professionals provide:

- Professional counseling services; including group, individual, and family counseling for substance use disorders
- Peer bonding, role modeling, relationship building, communication skills, behavioral therapy
- Focus on problem-solving, decision-making, and prioritizing skills
- Relapse prevention and refusal skills, values-based decision-making skills
- Behavioral analysis, reinforcement, and reward strategies
- Family educational programming, counseling, and therapy
- Team building, experiential, and fun activities including summer camping and ropes courses
- Exposure to 12 step programs, activities, and philosophy
- Educational programming including IEPs and specialty alternative learning center services
